- Plans are to grow the school by one grade each year until the 12th grade.
- All families pay tuition based on household income, tuition is due monthly.
- We follow Atlanta Public Schools calendar.
- Uniform shirts provided. (Khaki bottoms and comfortable shoes are the responsibility of parents.)
- All school supplies provided.

School Climate

- Our teachers use flexible learning groups, hands-on, research-based methods to develop their own curriculum guided by state and national learning standards.
- Focus on social emotional learning.
