- Monitor student progress and arrange for academic interventions based on formative and summative assessments.
- Serve as a resource in the area of mathematics for teachers, administrators, and families.
- Collaborate with teachers to ensure student mastery of standards by assisting with data-driven instructional planning, integration of technology, and implementation of research based strategies.
- Coordinate in-person conferences with parents/guardians and teachers to review student's progress.
